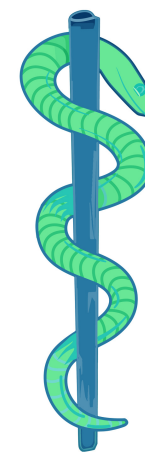




About Us
